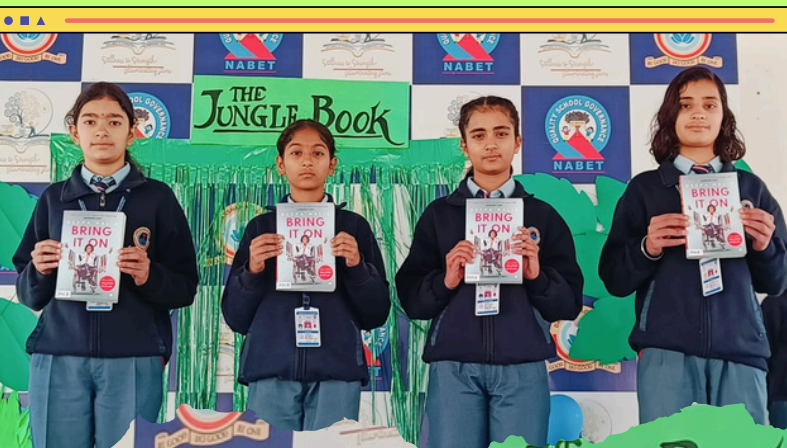

BLESSINGS CEREMONY



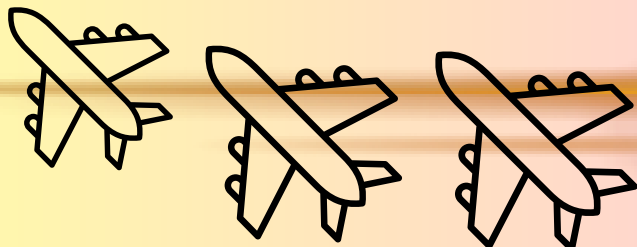
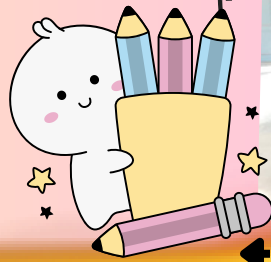

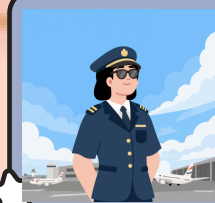
BLIND SCHOOL VISIT



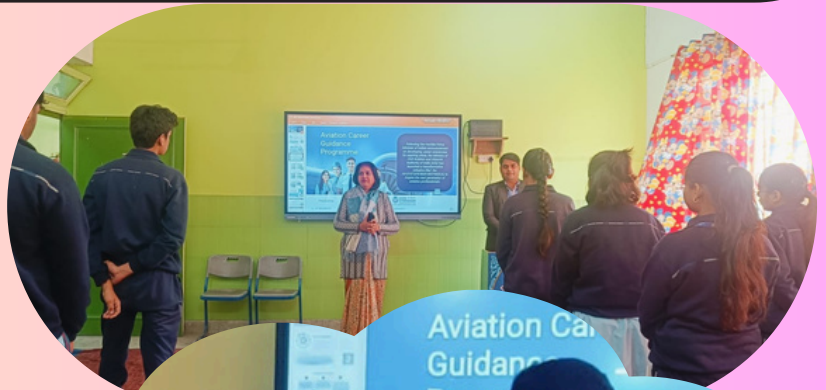

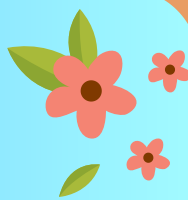

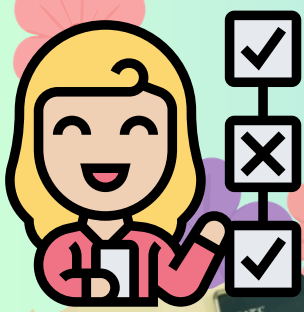
SPRING CAMP

"Learning becomes joyful when creativity, sports and fun come together."

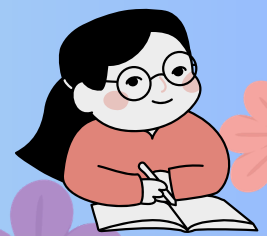
